The Cathedral Parish is a vibrant presence in the downtown community of Vancouver, British Columbia. Since its founding in 1885, the parish has played a critical role in the growth of the Catholic faith and culture of Vancouver. Mass is celebrated here four times a day on weekdays.

There are eight Sunday Masses including the anticipated Mass on Saturday evening and the Mass in Spanish. Confessions are heard everyday except Sunday. The beautiful cathedral is a designated heritage building with an interesting history. Its change-ringing bells, Nincheri stained-glass windows and a grand old organ also make it a popular tourist stop for visitors to Vancouver.
